The match between Linda Fruhvirtova (CZE) and Matilda Mutavdzik (GBR) looked to be real toss-up, but the Czech threat decided that it wasn't and ended the match swiftly. Amelia Waligora (BEL) surprised in her match, beating out the #2 ranked in Europe Erika Andreeva (RUS). It is also worth mentioning Barbora Palicova's (CZE) impressive form that she showed in her match.

I'm very happy to say that the trend of an increasingly international field is continuing, with a total of 11 nations represented in the last sixteen, Tournament Director Joe Beaton comments.
